Produce a Portugal visit fact-sheet (no moiré than 1 side of A4) 5. Portugal is famous for its Pousadas – using the information in the last training module, produce a presentation which explains and markets the Unique Selling Points(USPs) of Pousadas
<p>You have a choice of seven tourist regions to choose from. It will depend on what kind of holiday or visit people want to make – quiet countryside or busy seaside resort; cultural visit or golfing holiday – the choice is yours! As an example, this teacher guide will use:</p>

Describe the meaning of 'environmentally friendly' tourism as it applies to the Algarve? 3. Describe the actual or potential positive and negative socio-cultural impacts of tourists to the Algarve 4. Describe how golfing holidays to the Algarve are promoted 5. Explain the type, cost and relative convenience of different types of transport options for people travelling to the Algarve and getting around in the Algarve region 6. Make a list of 20 unique qualities of the Algarve that would attract tourist, and explain why they would be appealing to British tourists
